

Dear Chatham Residents,

The Town Board has met twice on-line and have conducted two virtual meetings. We have been using a Google platform. The public has access to these meetings, and we encourage you to watch and listen. All meeting dates will be posted in advance on our website and FB page. There is no provision for public comment yet, but we encourage you to email or call us with your comments. One of our goals is to keep community members involved in our town government during this time of social distancing.

The Board has reached an informal consensus (without a resolution) that summarizes our deliberation: all board committee meetings are on hold until May. As we are all aware, this decision about a restart of committee work is a hope and depends on how well Chatham does in the daily battle with this terrible disease. The intensity and seriousness of this pandemic has led the Board to conclude that the citizenry's health and safety as well as the Town's fiscal battle ahead need to be the Board's primary focus at this time.

The Board decided that it is the best policy to put all other non-essential business on the back burner. Accordingly, we have suspended regularly scheduled board committee meetings.
